#### Handling Change—How to Build Resilience in Yourself and Your Students, Laura Faudree, presenter Middle School Guide

Laura developed and will be presenting this workshop at the 2024 annual American Montessori Society conference in Orlando, Florida

Ever wonder what makes some people appear to move through life with ease? While it's easy to think their lives are trouble-free, the reality lies in their ability to show resilience. Their ability to endure difficulties, yet keep moving. How do we help our students get there? Ourselves? Together, we will identify resiliency building components of a Montessori middle school, our role as guides to inspire the students we serve, and what we can do to help students develop a habit of resilience.

#### Creating a Brave Classroom, Gretchen Sterba

Upper Elementary Guide

Gretchen participated in this summer course offered by Britt Hawthorne, a Montessori trained classroom teacher, author, and anti bias educator. This course focused on four aspects of social



justice standards of self love and identity, embracing differences, justice, and activism. She found the topics inspiring, and loved Britt's down-to-earth, compassionate and curious approach, which reflects what Gretchen strives for in her classroom. Gretchen

completed the course with the sense that our community does a great job of

touching on these four standards, and discovered opportunities to go a bit deeper.



#### Deep Dive: The Elementary and Adolescent Class Meeting, Anita Hundley and Gretchen Sterba Upper Elementary Guide

Over the past couple of years, we as a school have implemented a new format for class meetings. The goal is to increase student input in classroom management, leading to greater connection and cooperation. Taking the three-session summer course, "Deep Dive: The Elementary and Adolescent Class Meeting" by Chip DeLorenzo (live via Zoom), was an opportunity for Anita and Gretchen to reflect and improve on their practice in facilitating these meetings. In this course, they were grouped with other Montessori guides whose experiences mirrored what they experience with their own Undercroft students. Individually and in groups they developed and tested lessons based on new guidelines provided by the instructor. A sequence was provided for presenting lessons geared toward building skills to improve participation and communication within the class meeting (all of which, naturally, will impact participation and communication in all areas of the classroom). Anita and Gretchen are in the early weeks of presenting these lessons, and are enjoying the
